## Executive Summary

### **Fall 2016**

The undergraduate enrollment of 8,791 included 1,469 first-time in college students, 625 new transfer students, 1,721 dual credit students, and 4,976 returning students. Eighty percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-six percent of students are female, and forty-eight percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 24.0 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-seven percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), forty percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 9.0. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to forty-five percent and the average credit hour load is 9.3.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (37.3%), General Studies (26.60%), Business Administration and Management (3.4%), Registered Nursing (3.0%), and General Business/Commerce (2.8%).

### **Fall 2015**

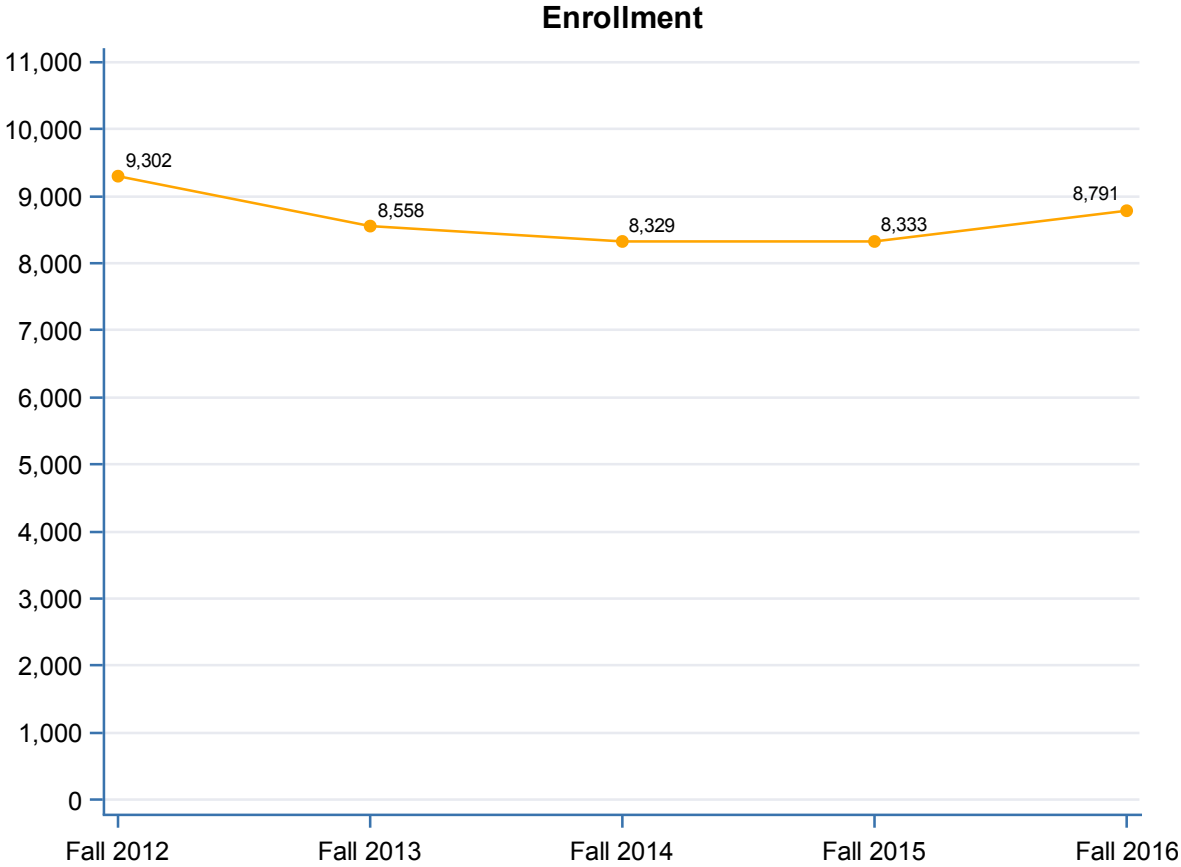
The undergraduate enrollment of 8,333 included 1,342 first-time in college students, 632 new transfer students, 1,396 dual credit students, and 4,963 returning students. Eighty-one percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-six percent of students are female, and forty-six percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty-one percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 24.6 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-five percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), forty-two percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 9.2. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to fifty-nine percent and the average credit hour load is 9.4.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (35.2%), General Studies (24.0%), Business Administration and Management (4.2%), General Business/Commerce (3.1%), and Registered Nursing (3.0%).

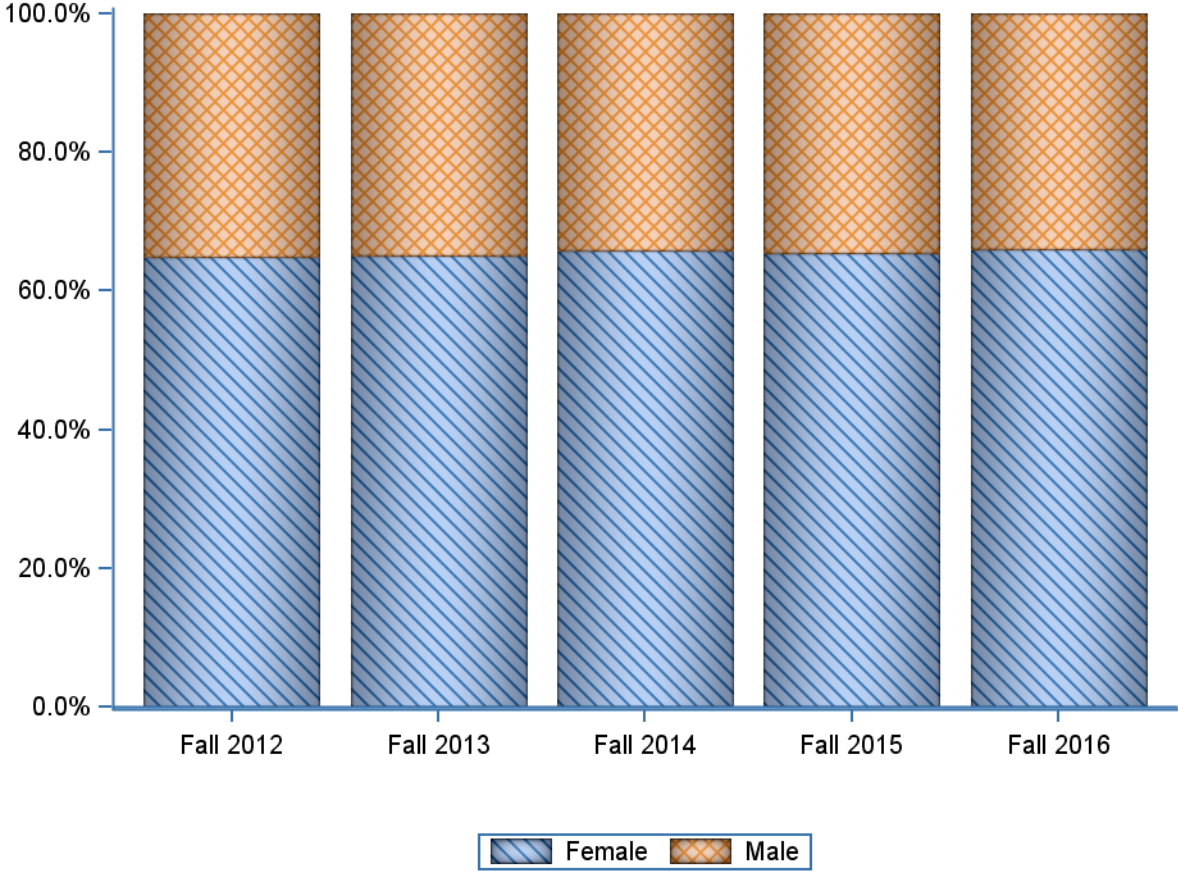

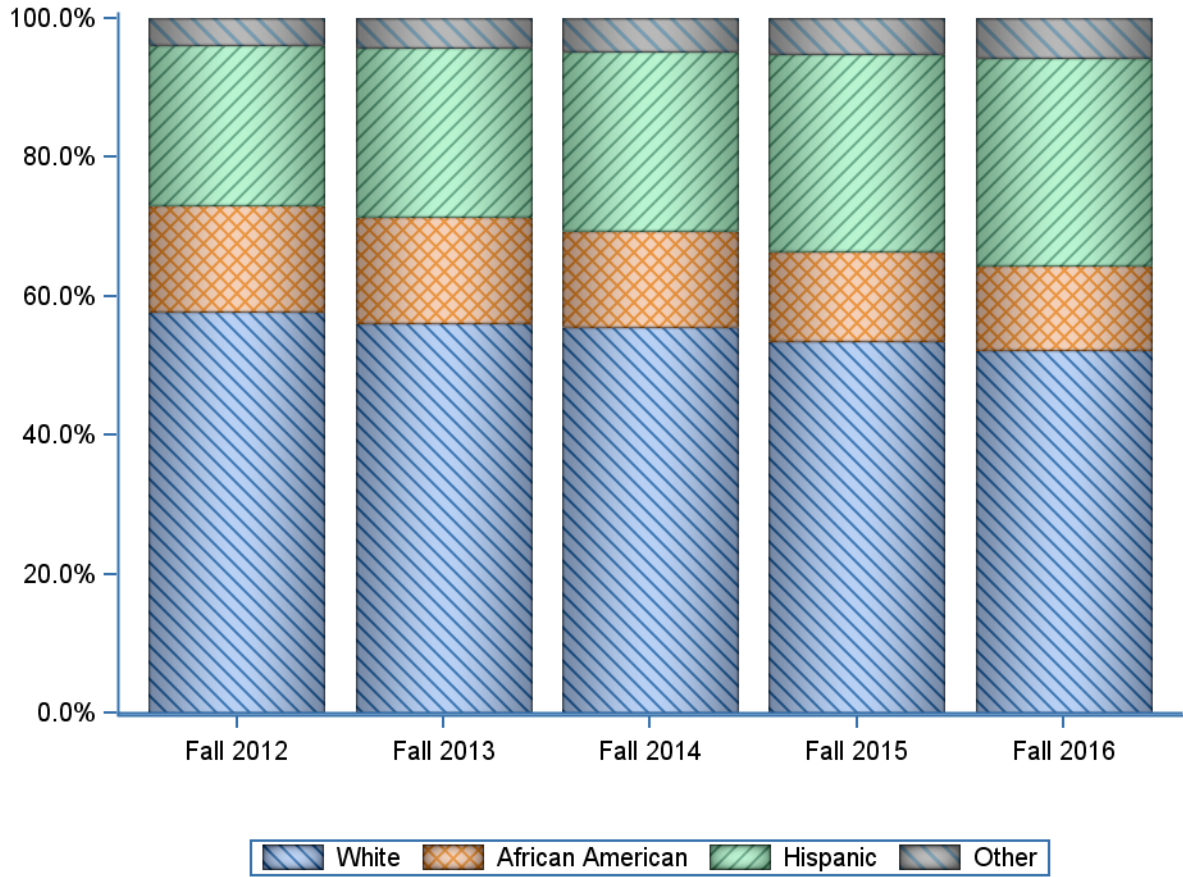
**Percent of Enrollment**

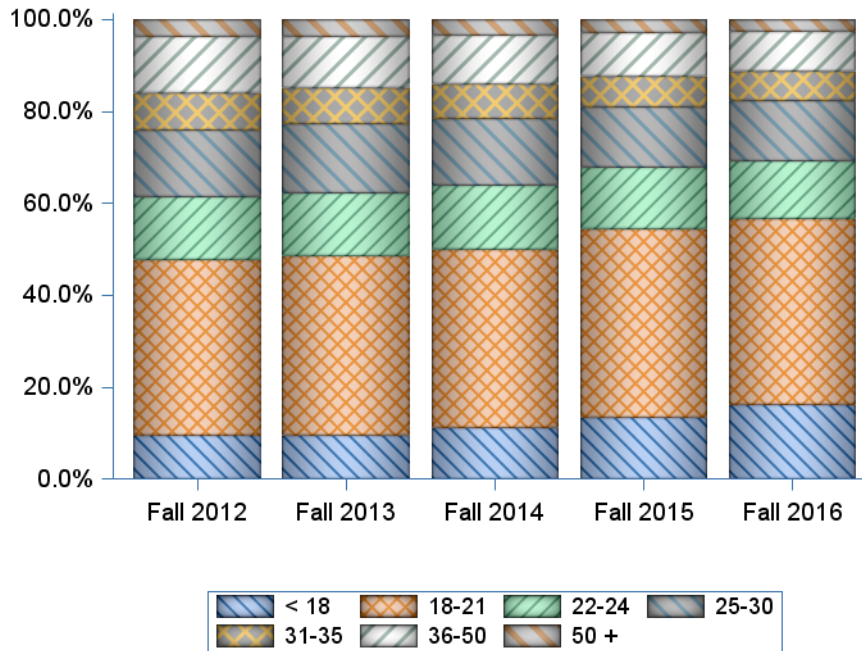
### Percent of Enrollment



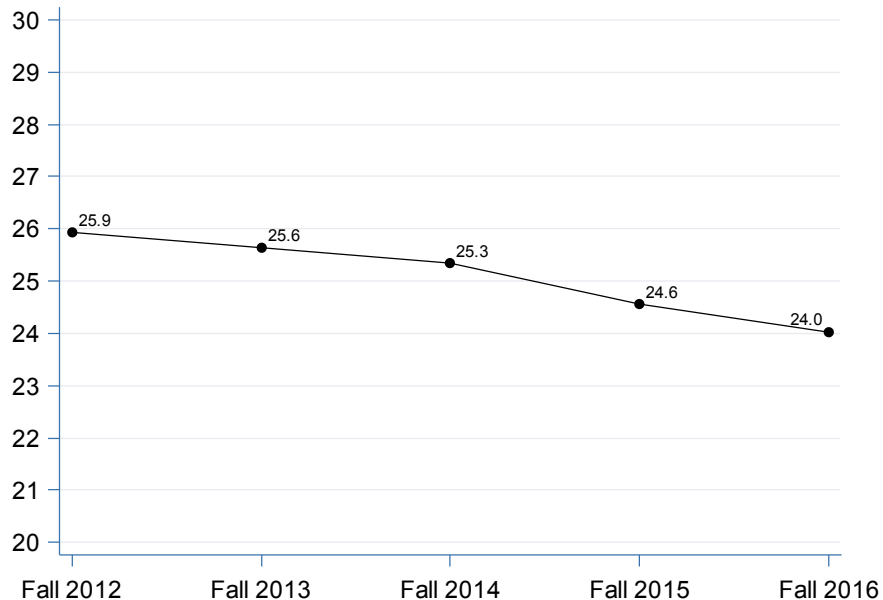

### Percent of Enrollment

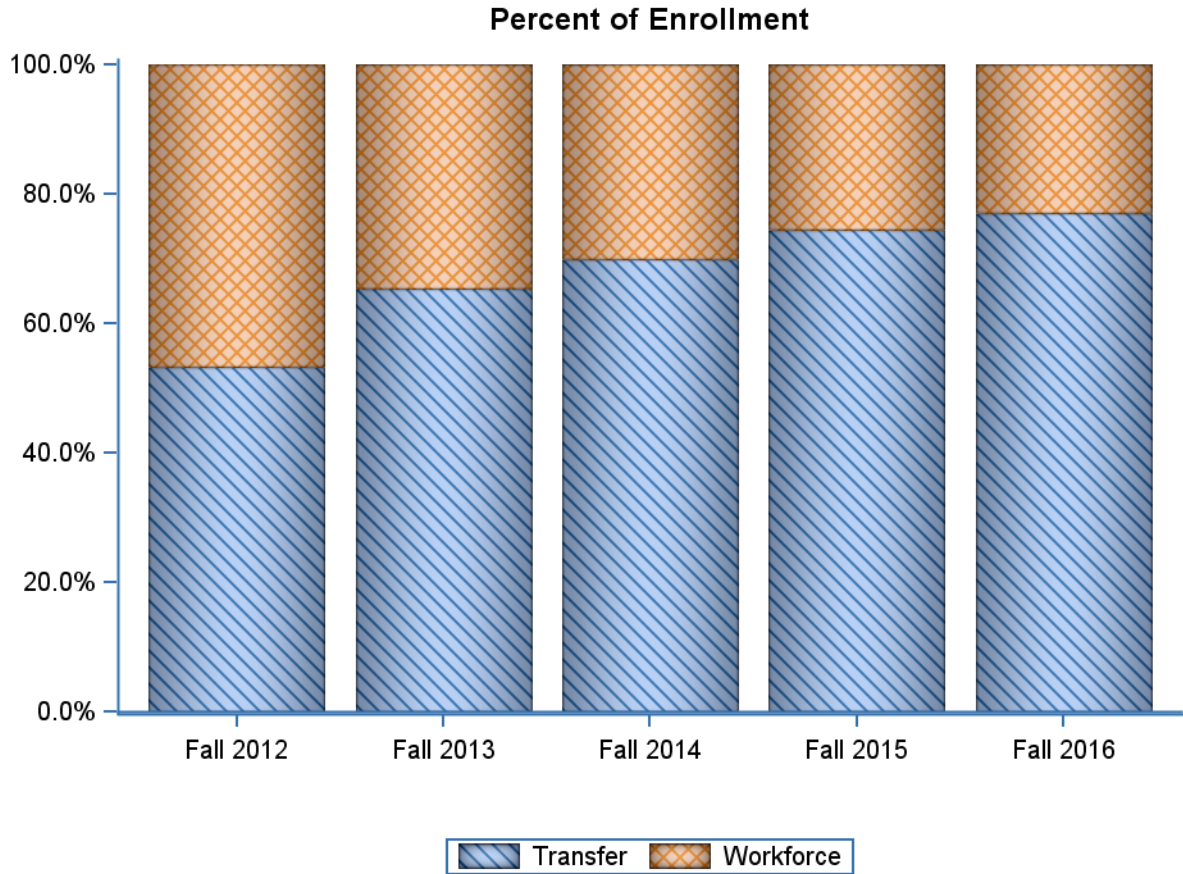


### Average Age

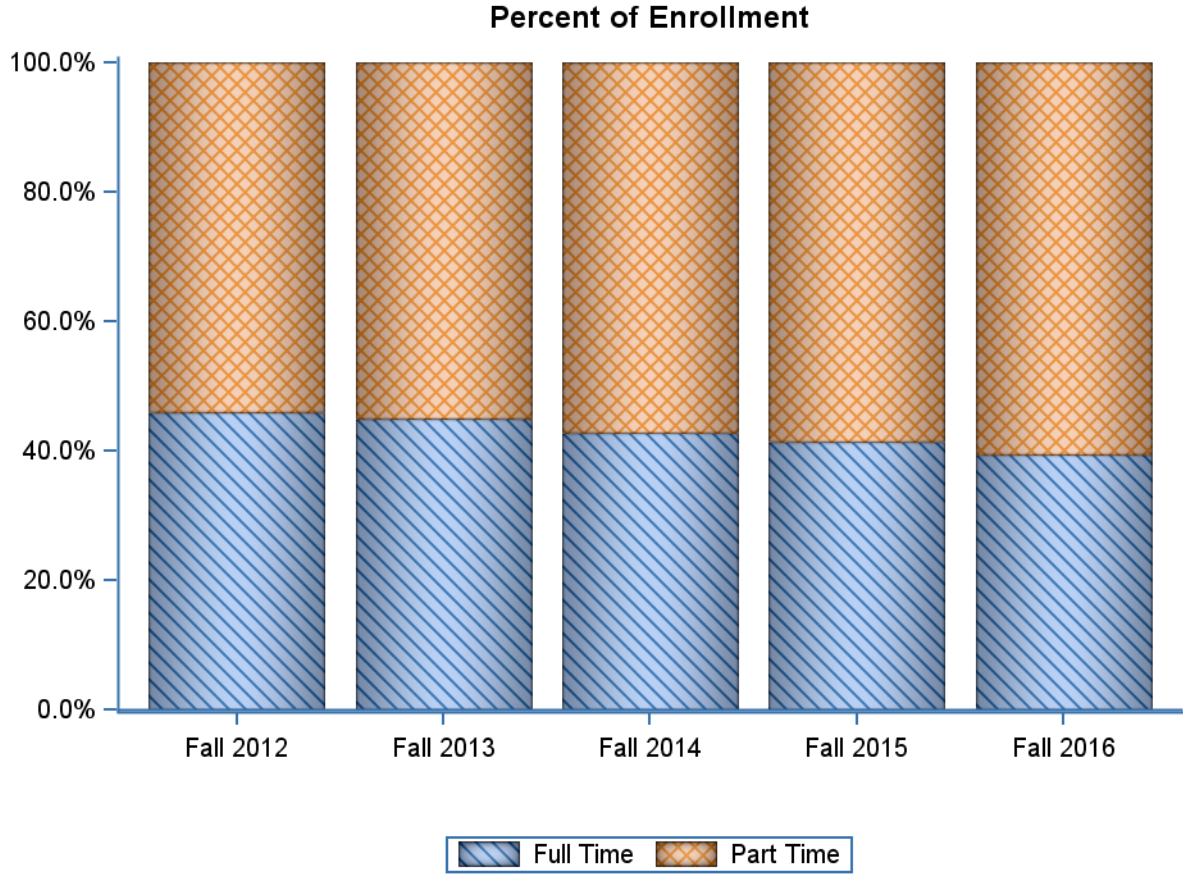

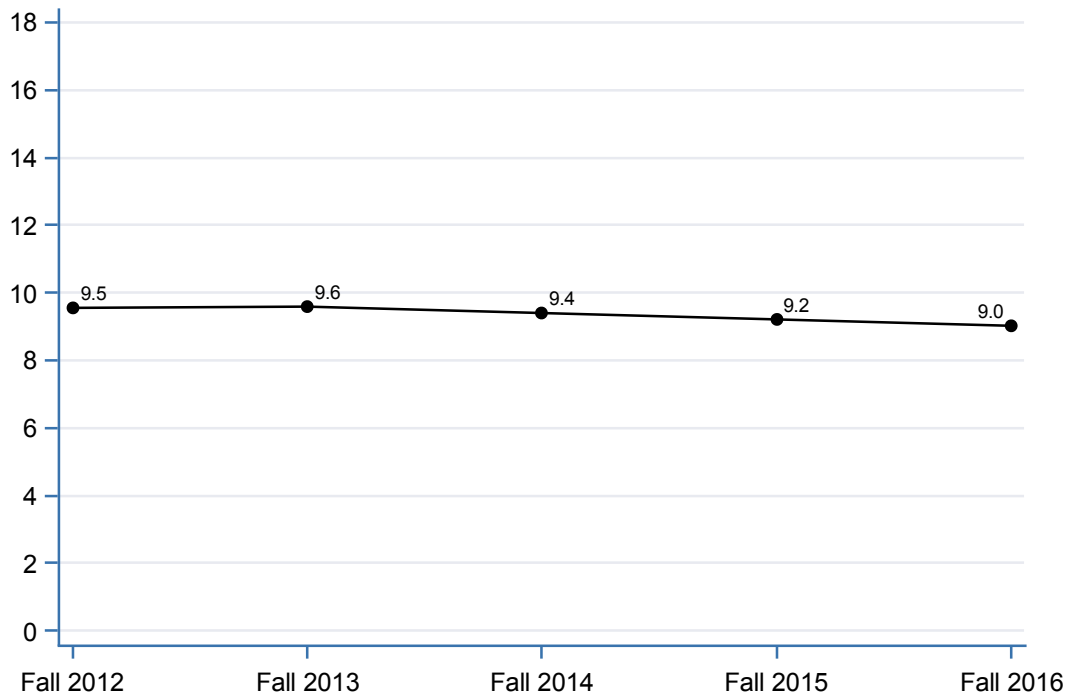

### Average Hours

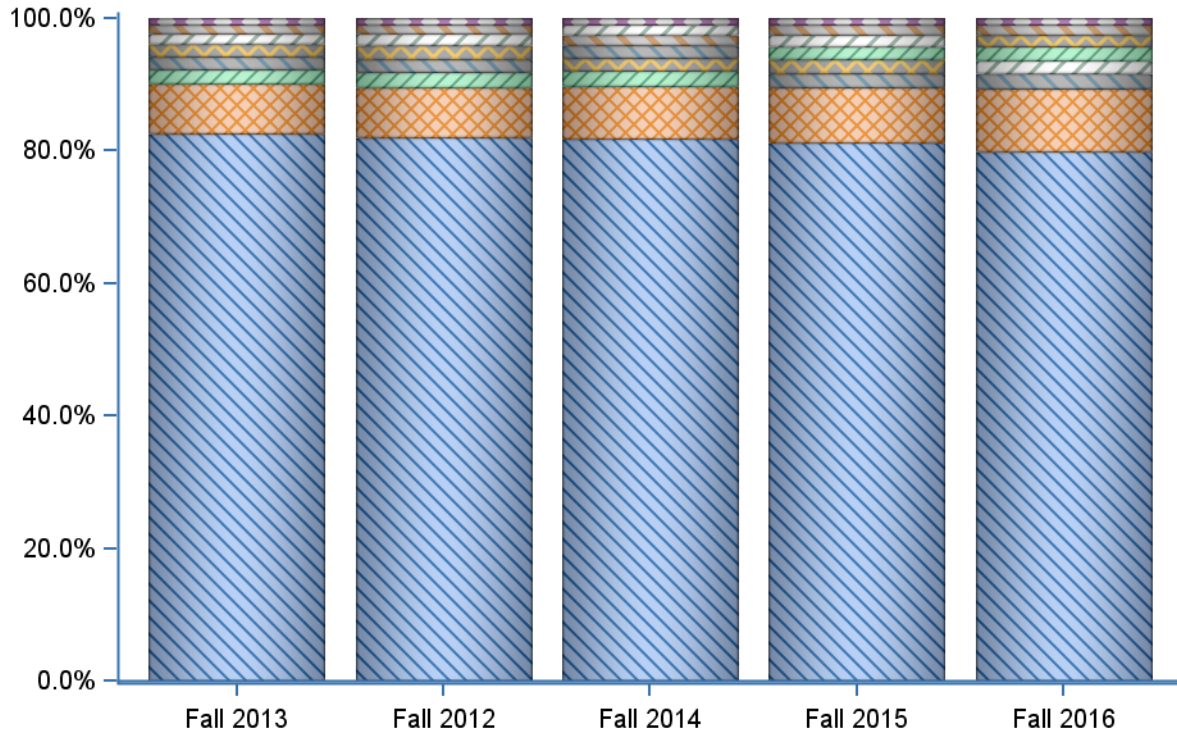

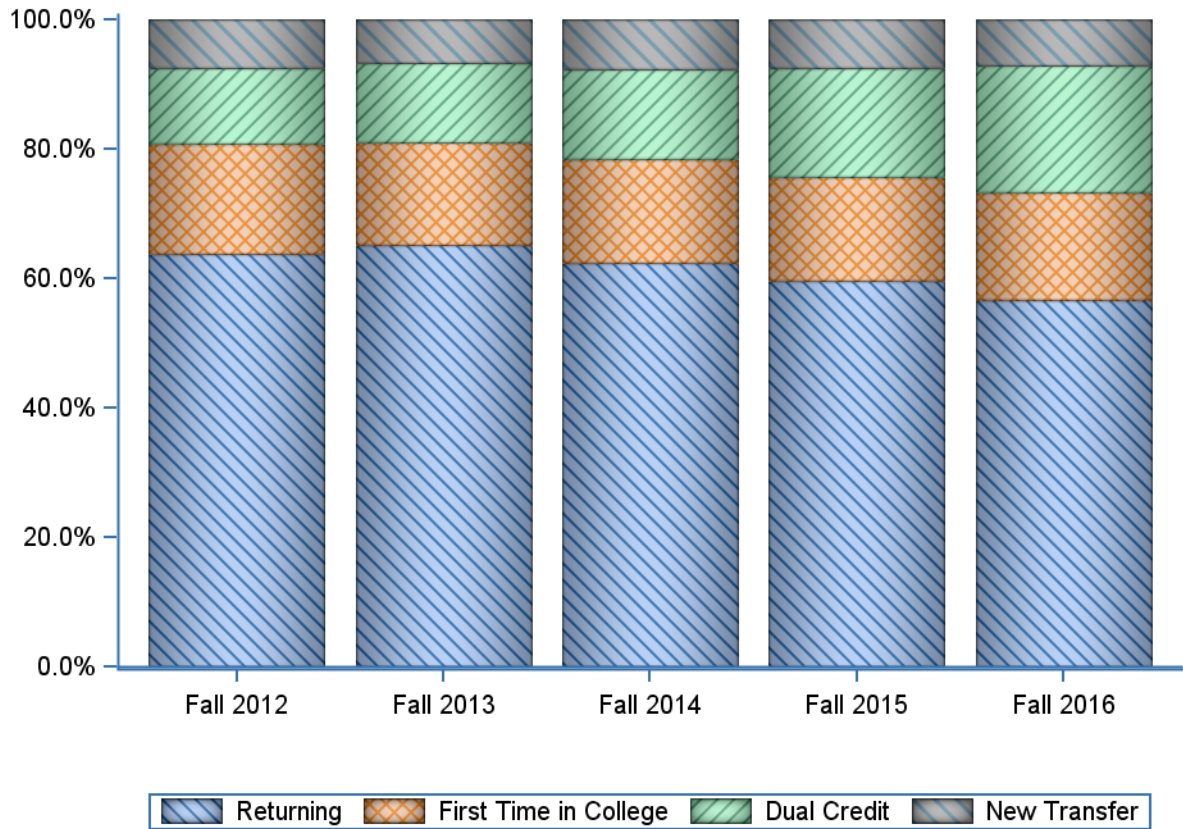
### Percent of Enrollment

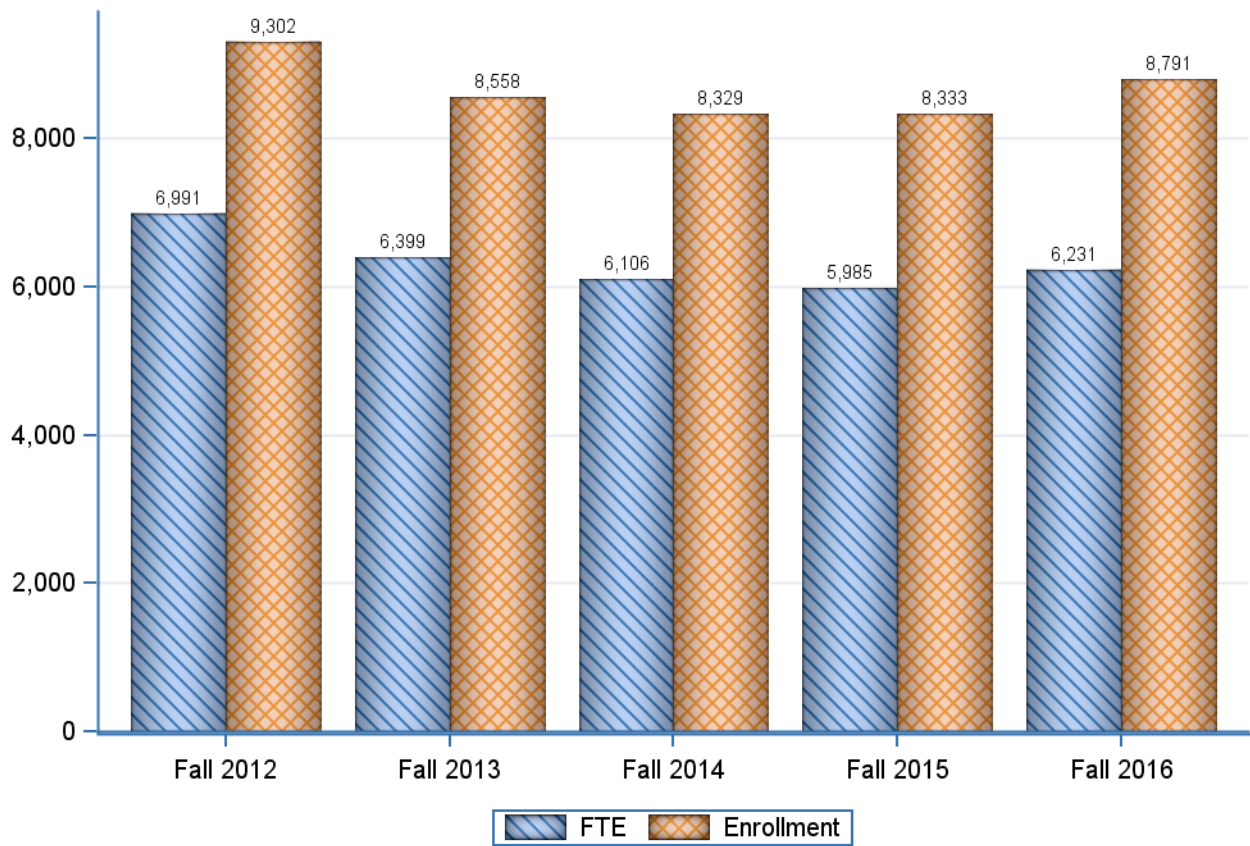
