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Executive Summary

Fall 2016

The undergraduate new transfer enrollment is 625. Forty-five percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-three percent of students are female, and forty-four percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-two percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 27.6 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-two percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), Forty-eight percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 10.0. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to fifty-seven percent and the average credit hour load is 10.5.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are General Studies (32.4%), Liberal Arts & Sciences (18.7%), Transient, non-Degree Seeker (6.3%), Hospital and Health Care Facilities Administration/Management (4.1%), and General Business/Commerce (4.1%).

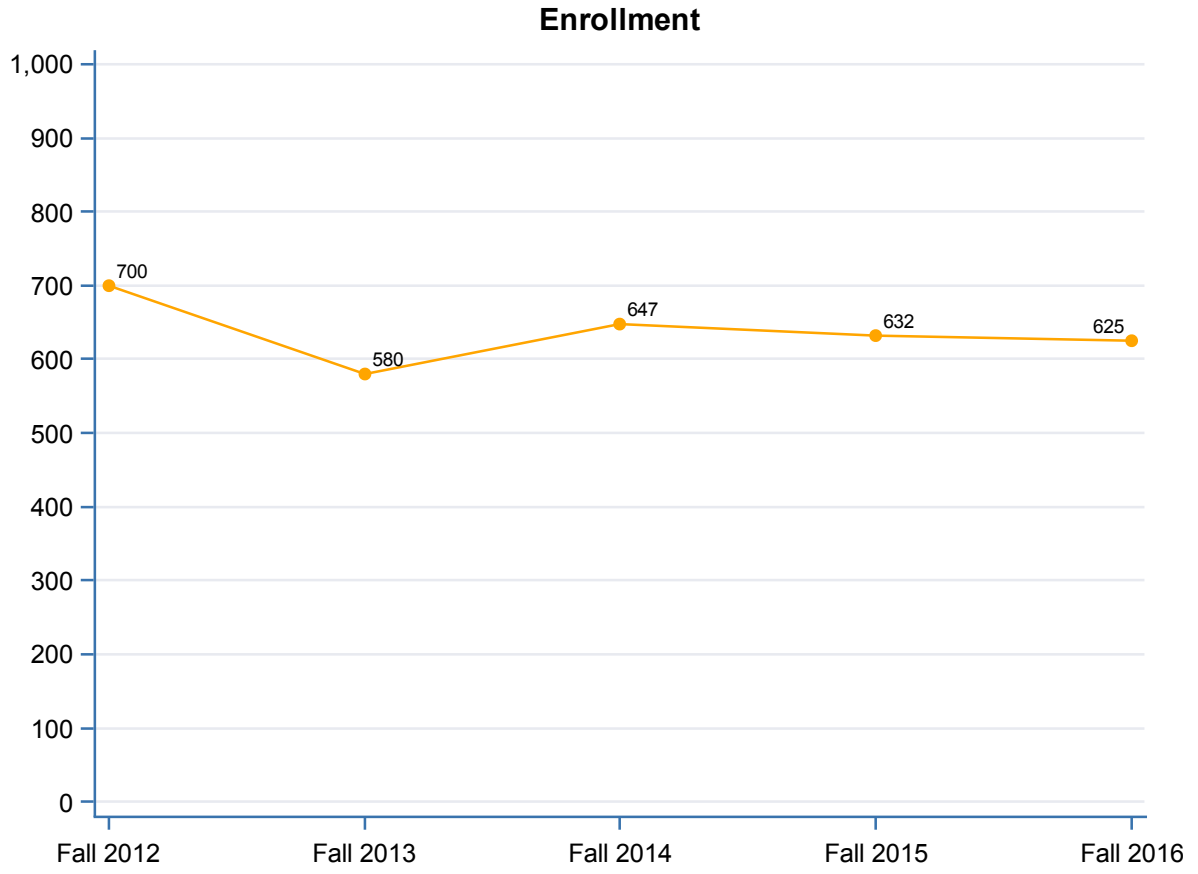
The undergraduate new transfer enrollment is 632. Fifty-four percent are from McLennan County. Fifty-eight percent of students are female, and forty-two percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-eight percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 27.0 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), forty-six percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 9.8. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to sixty-seven percent and the average credit hour load is 14.3.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are General Studies (28.9%), Liberal Arts & Sciences (20.9%), Business Administration and Management (5.5%), Hospital and Health Care Facilities Administration/Management (5.3%), and General Business/Commerce (4.1%).

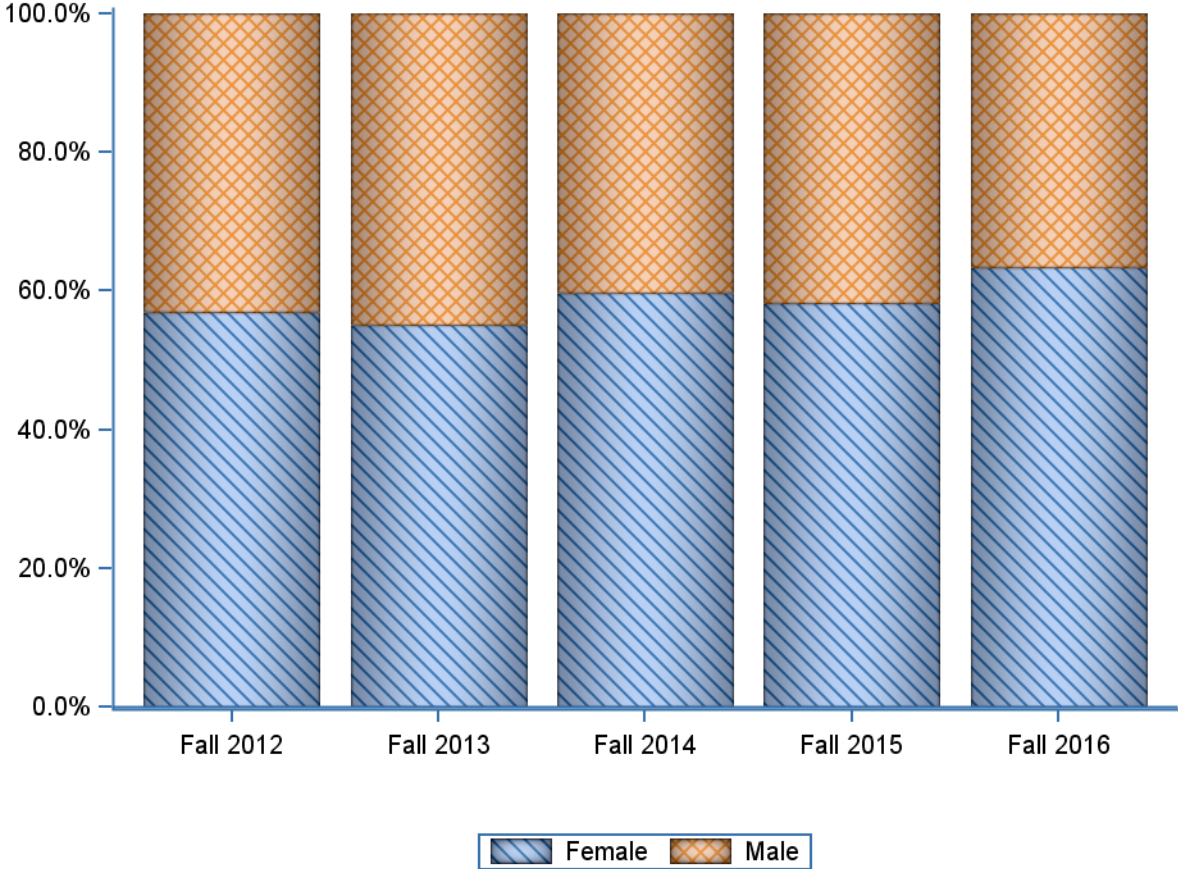

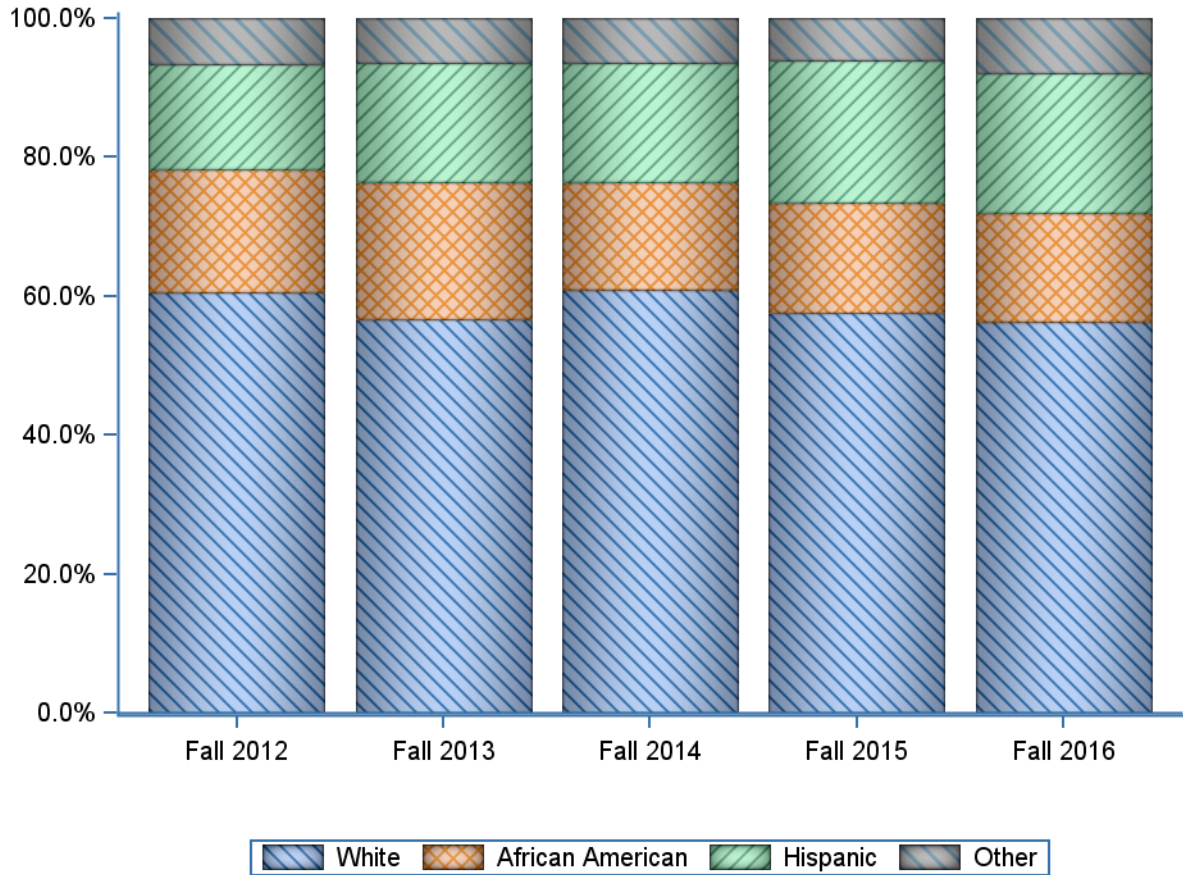
Percent of Enrollment

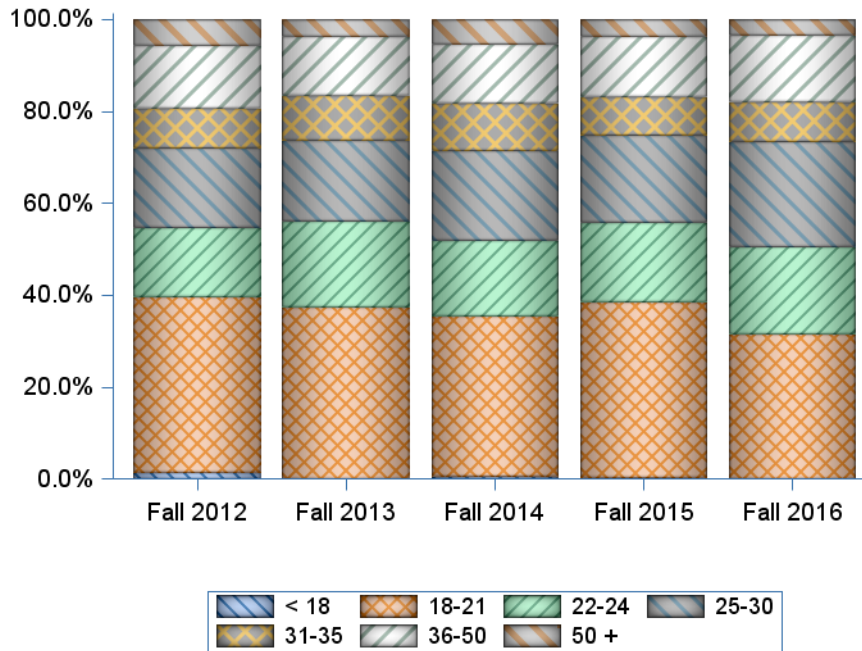
Percent of Enrollment



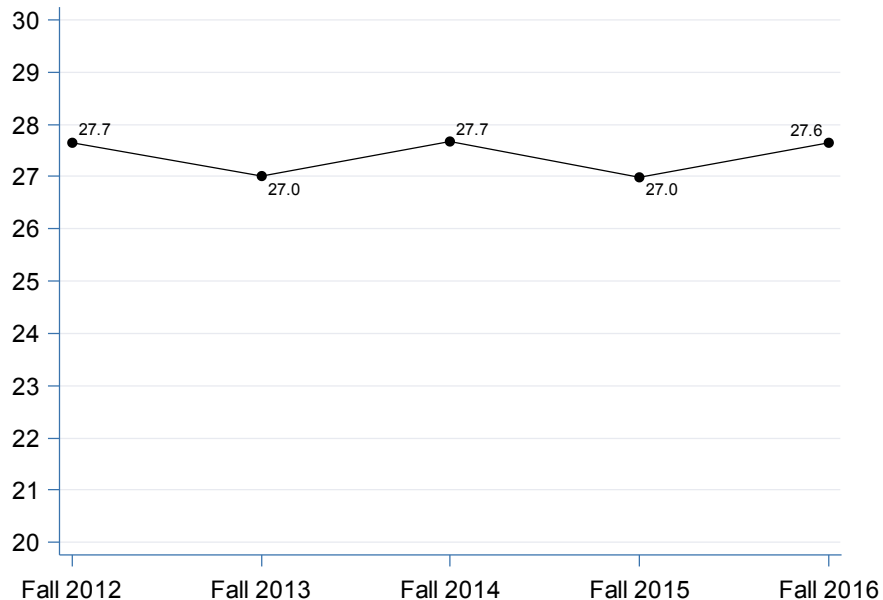

Percent of Enrollment

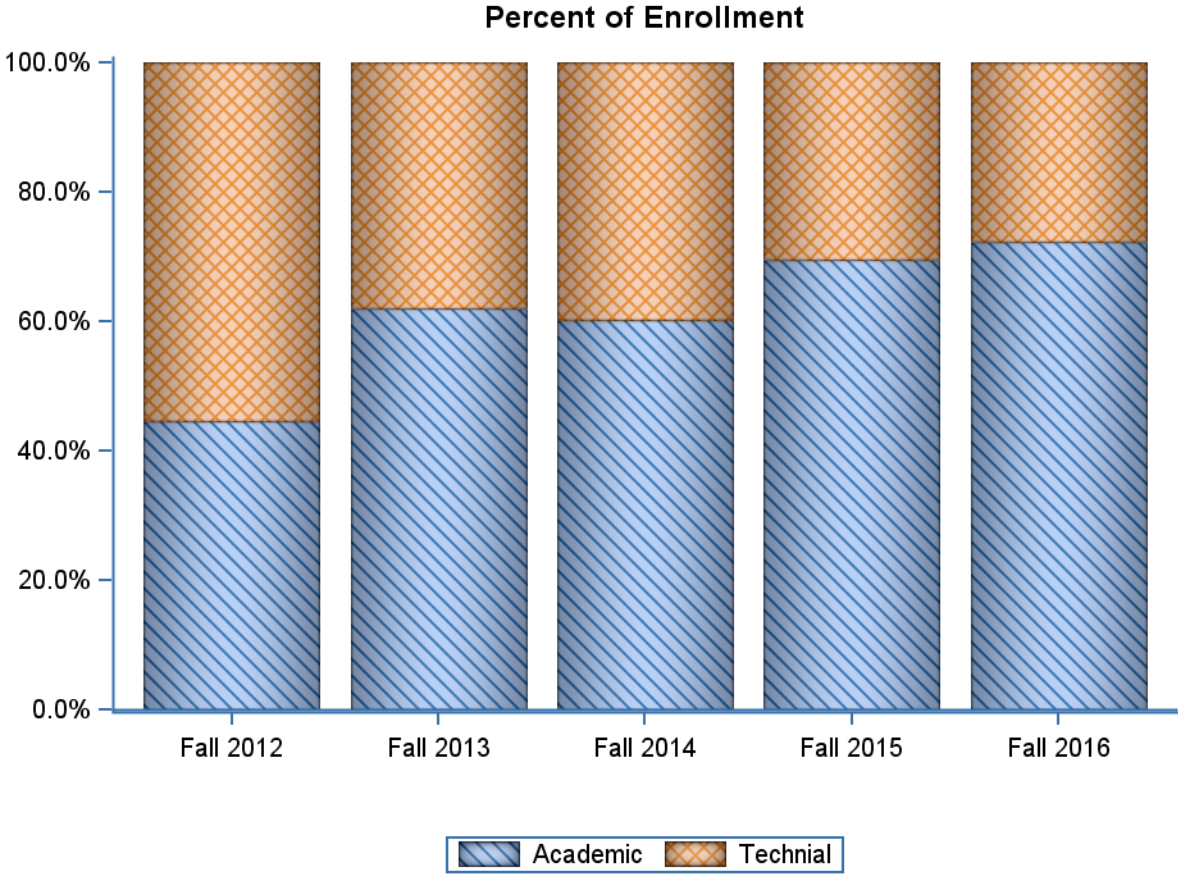


Average Age

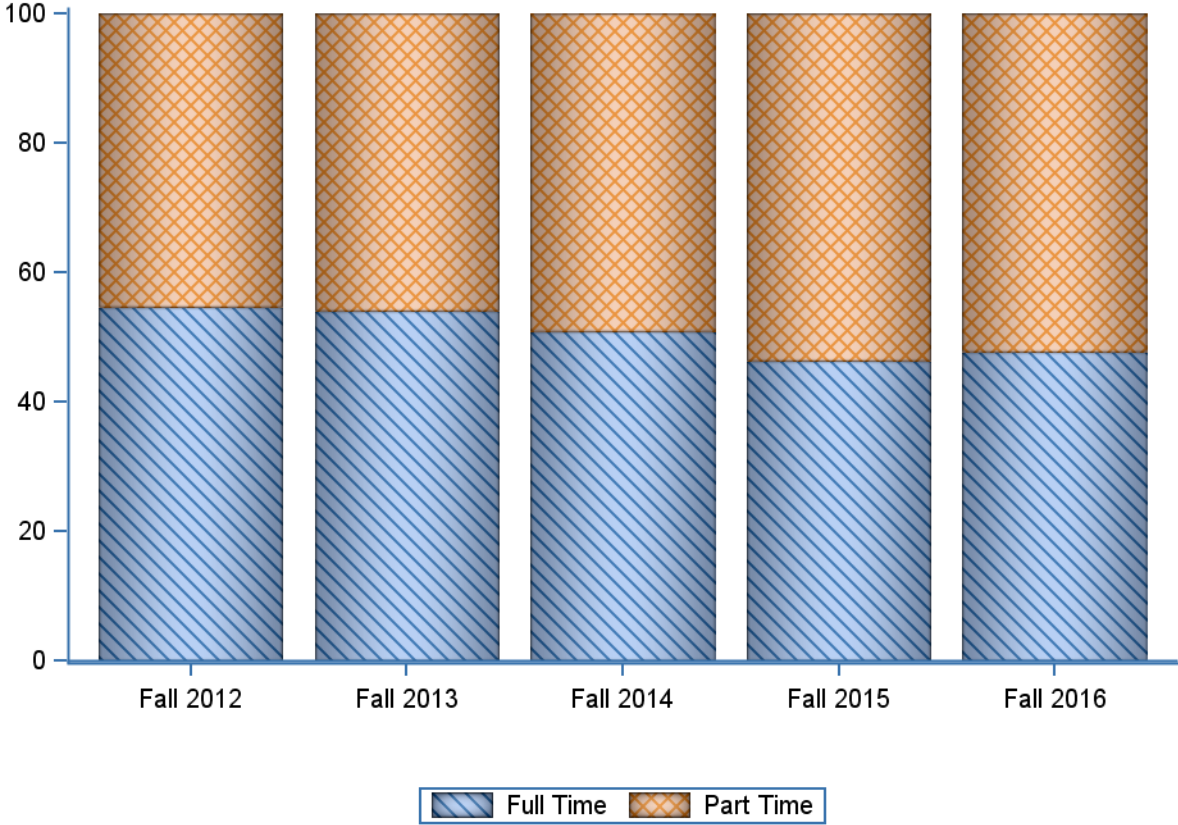

Percent of Enrollment

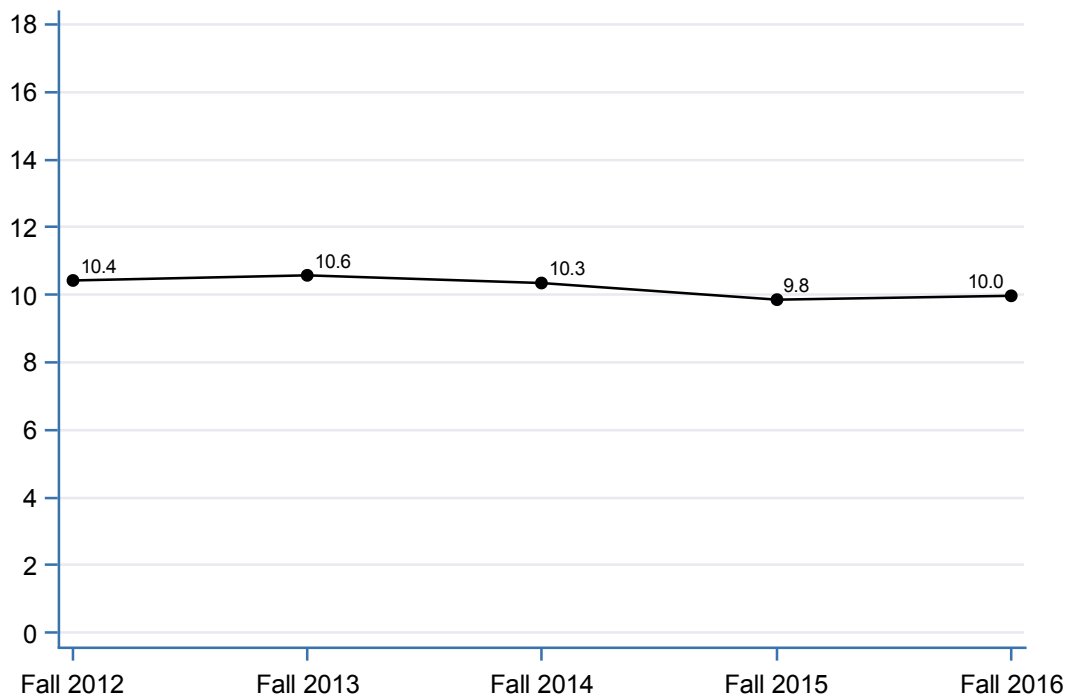

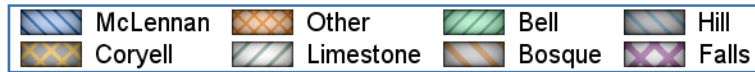
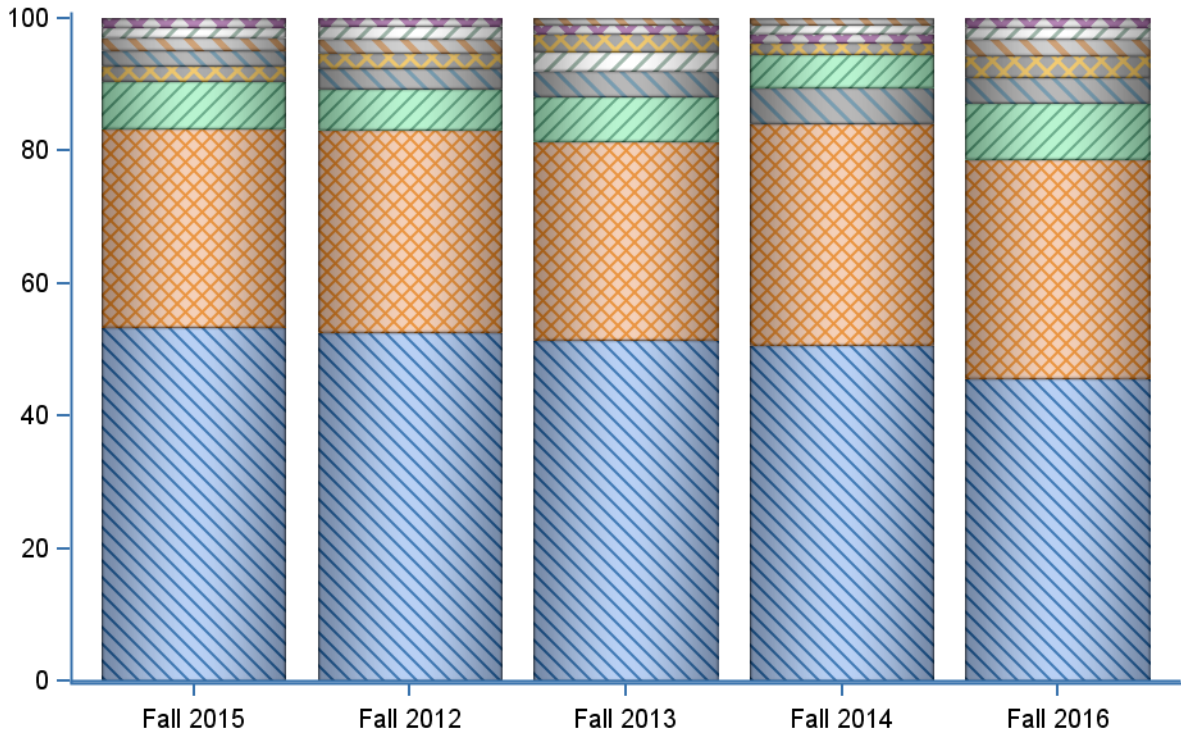
