Executive Summary

Fall 2017

The undergraduate new transfer enrollment is 468. Forty-six percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-three percent of students are female, and forty-eight percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-eight percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 27.3 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Sixty-five percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), Forty-seven percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 9.9. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students goes to eight-nine percent and the average credit hour load is 15.7.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (32.5%), General Studies (13.7%), Transient, non-Degree Seeker (12.0%), Business Administration and Management, General (4.9%), and Medical Assistant (4.1%).

Fall 2016

The undergraduate new transfer enrollment is 625. Forty-six percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-three percent of students are female, and forty-four percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-two percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 27.6 years at the beginning of the fall term.


Seventy-three percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), Forty-eight percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 10.0. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students goes to eighty-eight percent and the average credit hour load is 15.3.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are General Studies (32.4%), Liberal Arts & Sciences (18.7%), Transient, non-Degree Seeker (6.3%), Hospital and Health Care Facilities Administration/Management (4.1%), and General Business/Commerce (4.1%).




Percent of Enrollment










Profile of New Transfer Students, Fall 2013 to Fall 2017 Age Category





Profile of New Transfer Students, Fall 2013 to Fall 2017 Full-Time/Part-Time Status




