## Executive Summary

### **Spring 2017**

The undergraduate enrollment of 9,871 included 255 first-time in college students, 312 new transfer students, 1,726 dual credit students, and 7,435 returning students. Seventy-eight percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-six percent of students are female, and forty-eight percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty-two percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 24.9 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-three percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), thirty percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 7.8. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to forty-six percent and the average credit hour load is 10.5.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (34.8%), General Studies (23.1%), Transient, Non-Degree Seeker (6.3%), Business Admin & Management (3.5%), and Registered Nursing (3.1%).

### **Spring 2016**

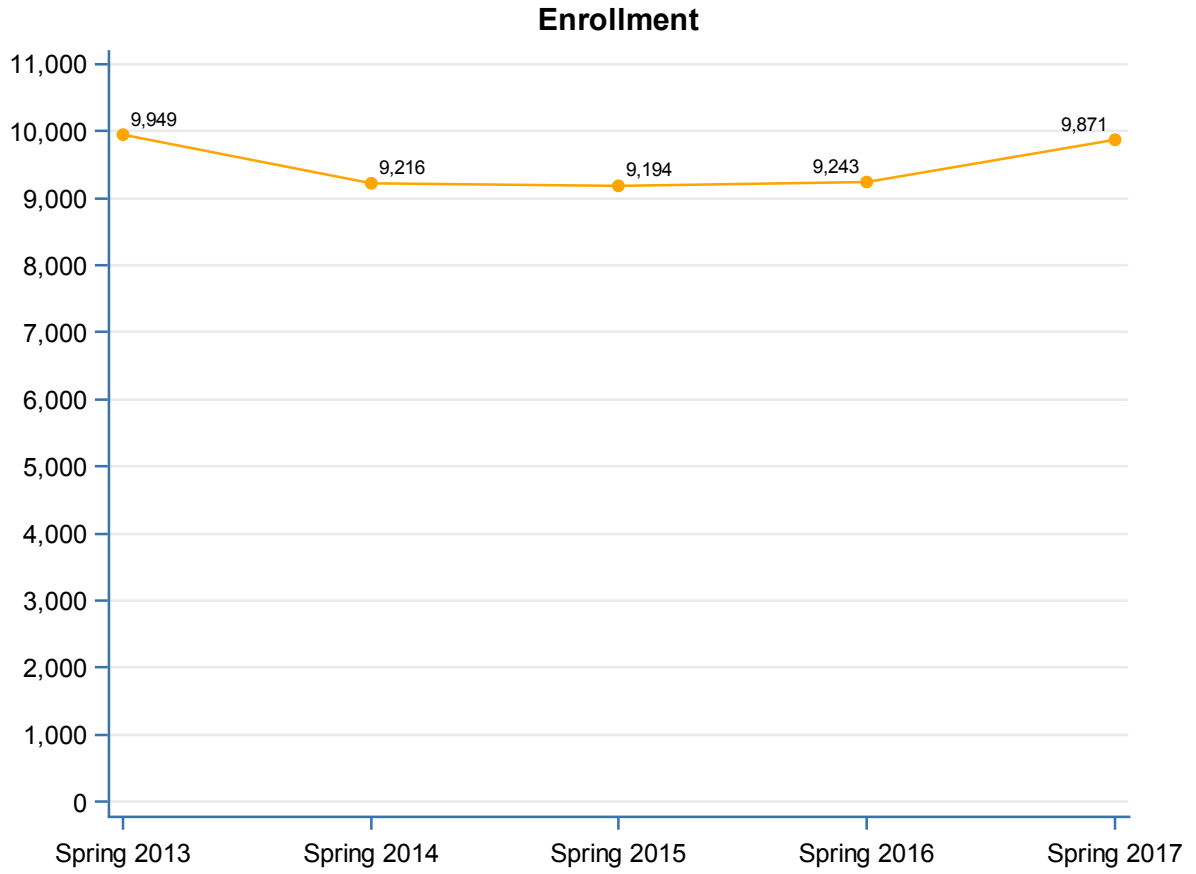
The undergraduate enrollment of 9,243 included 255 first-time in college students, 405 new transfer students, 1,343 dual credit students, and 7,240 returning students. Eighty percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-six percent of students are female, and forty-six percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty-two percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 25.7 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-five percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), thirty-two percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 8.1. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to forty-eight percent and the average credit hour load is 10.7.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (37.3%), General Studies (26.6%), Business Administration and Management (3.4%), Registered Nursing (3.0%), and General Business/Commerce (2.8%).

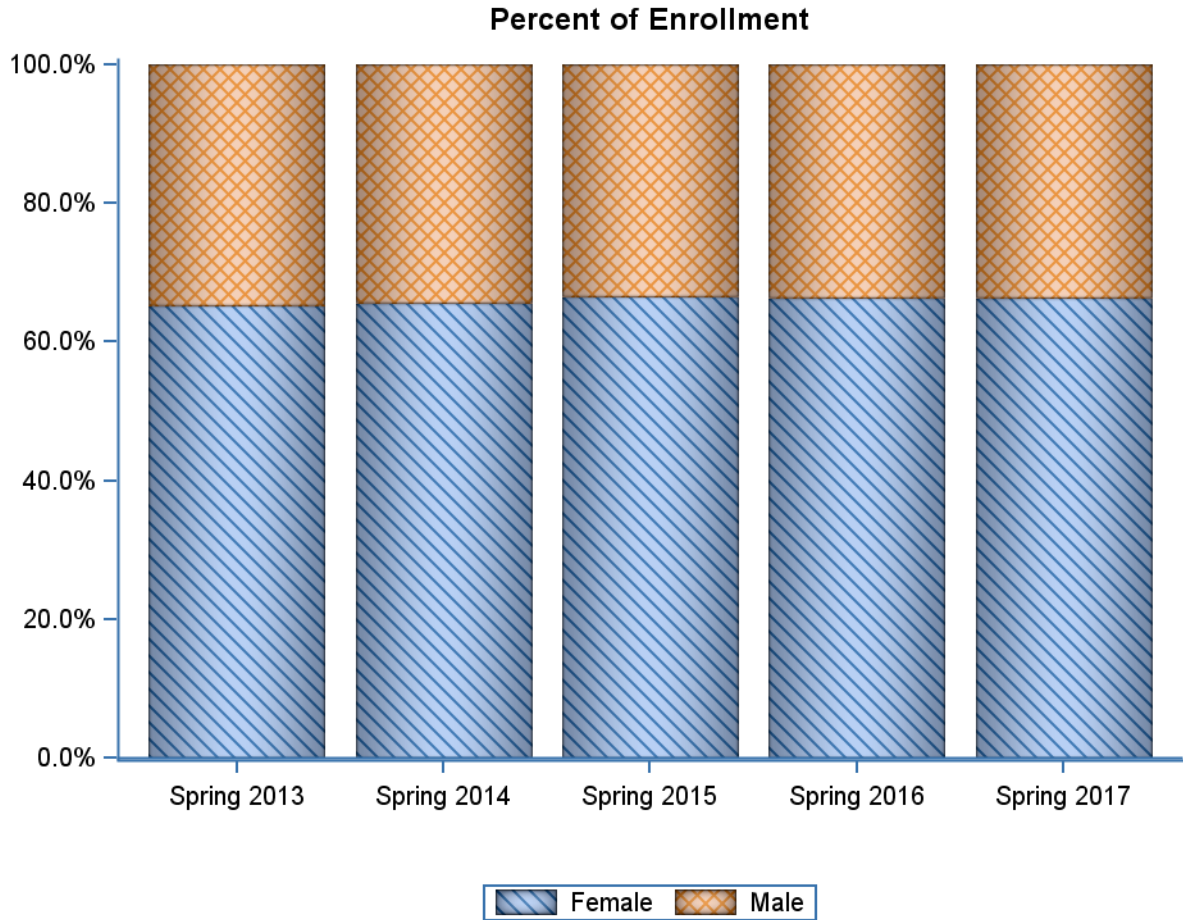

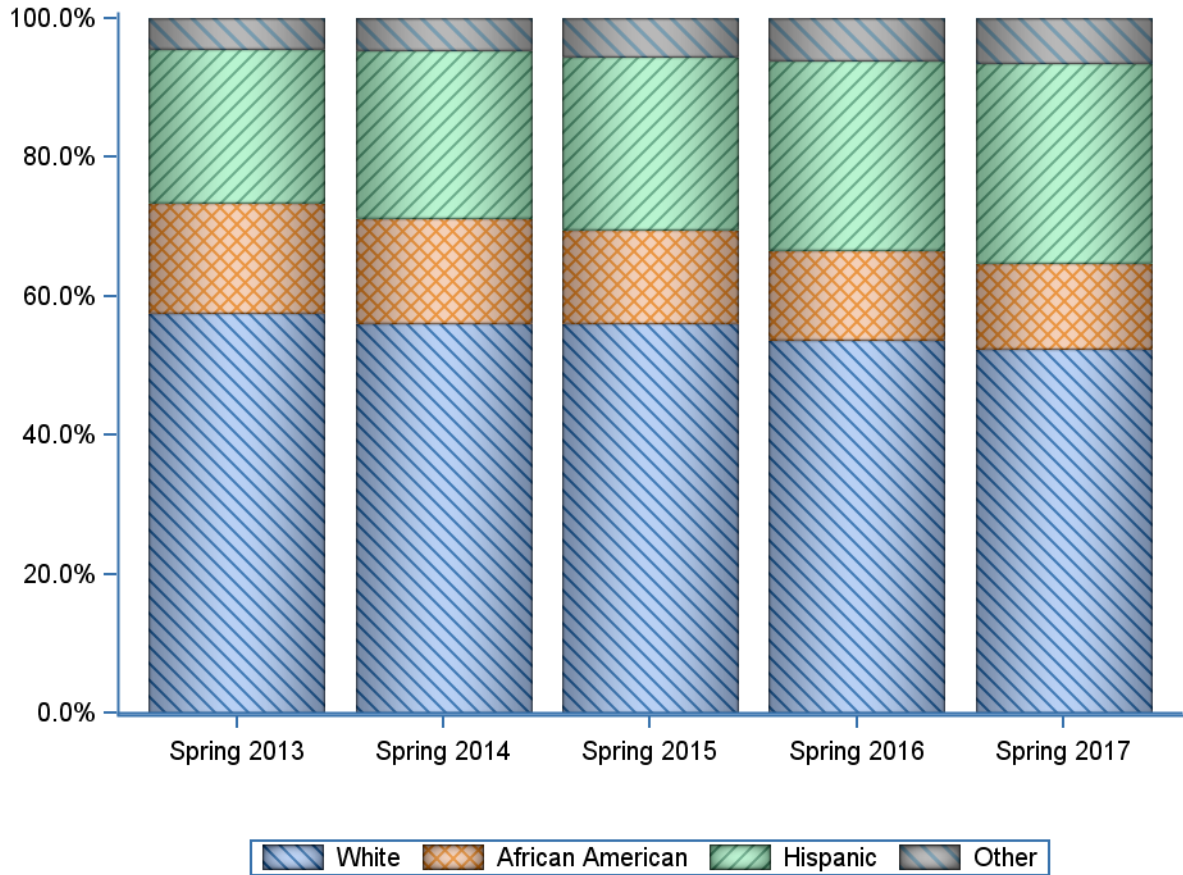

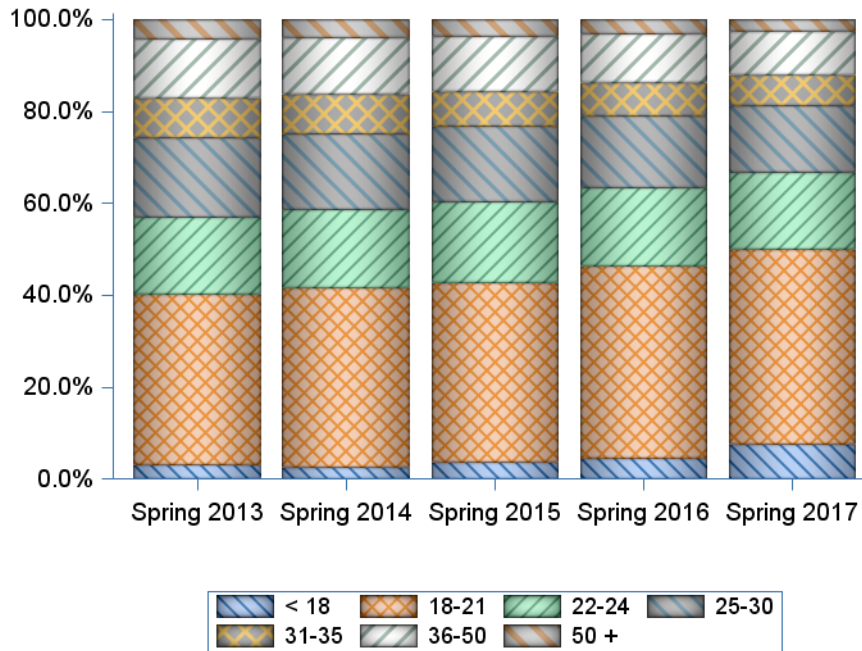
### Percent of Enrollment



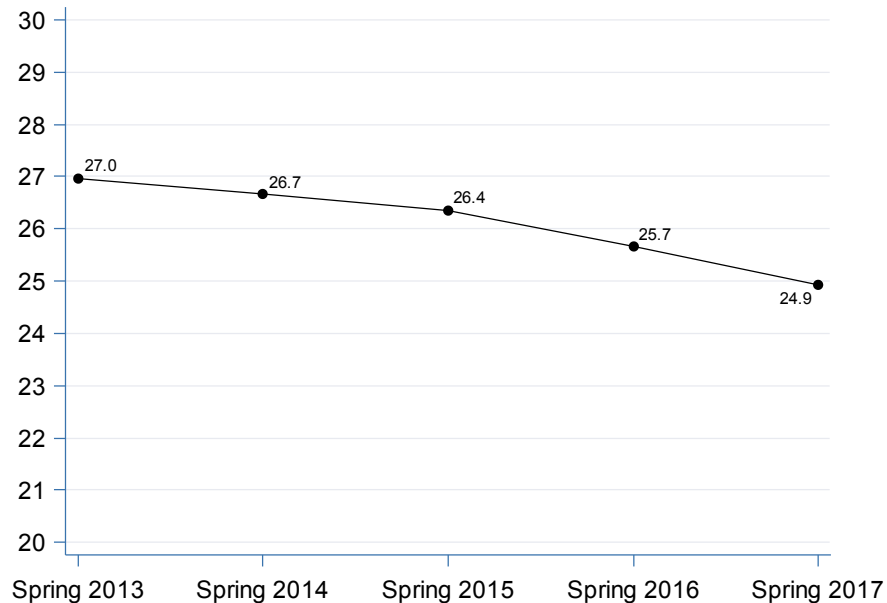

### Percent of Enrollment

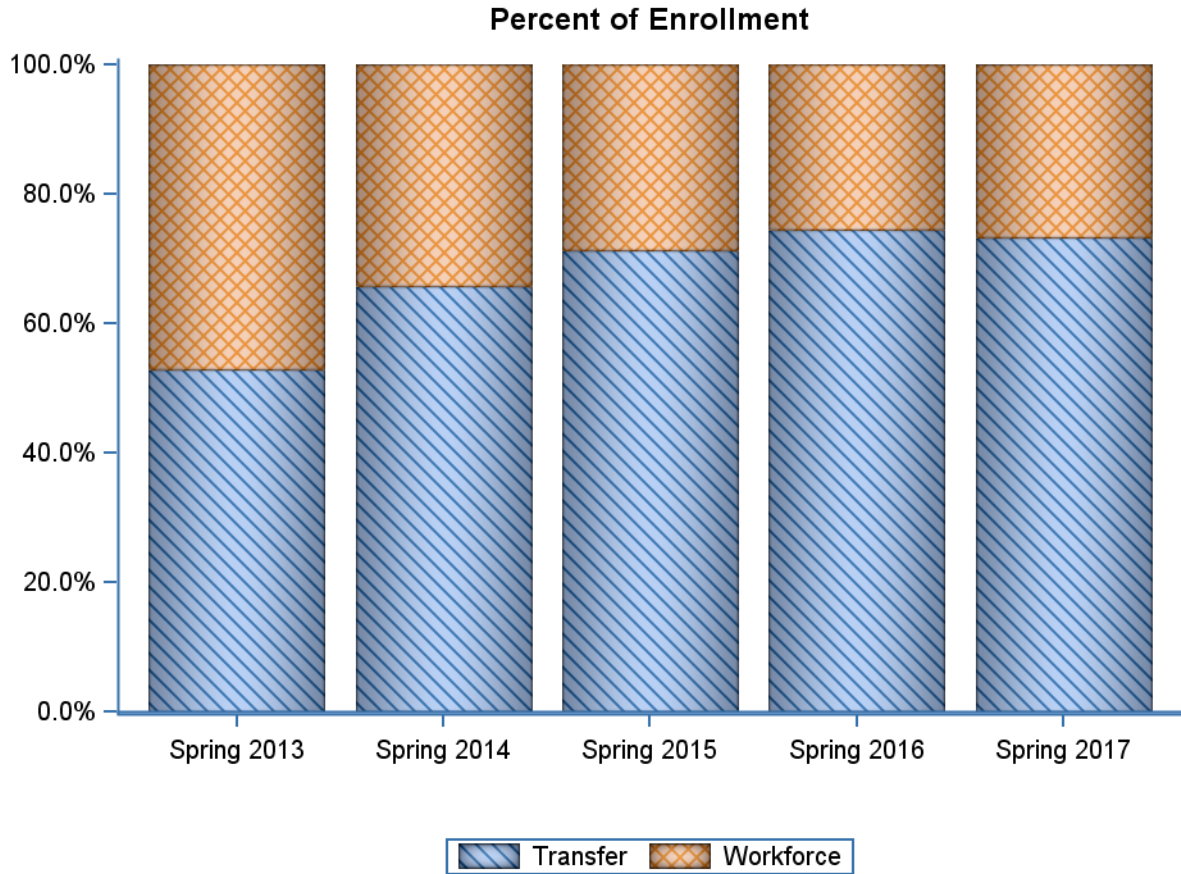


### Average Age

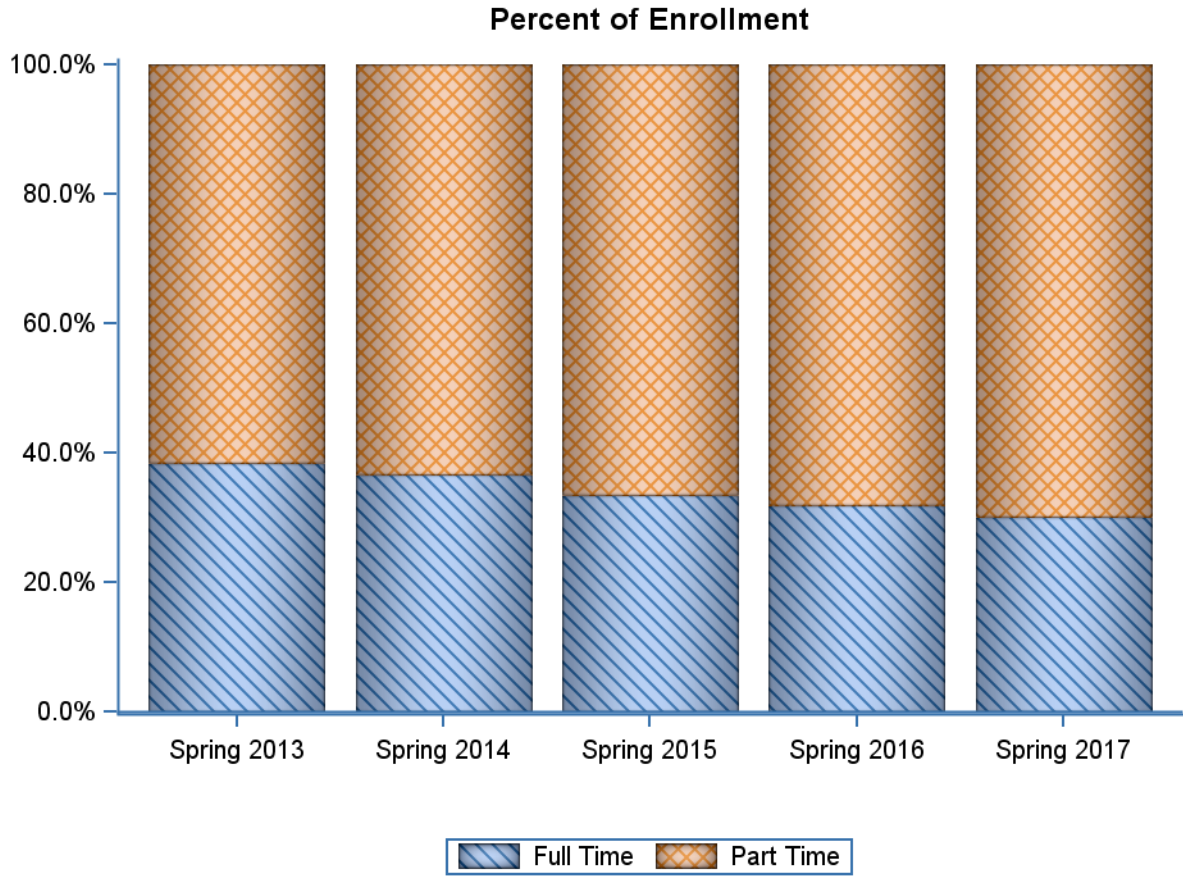

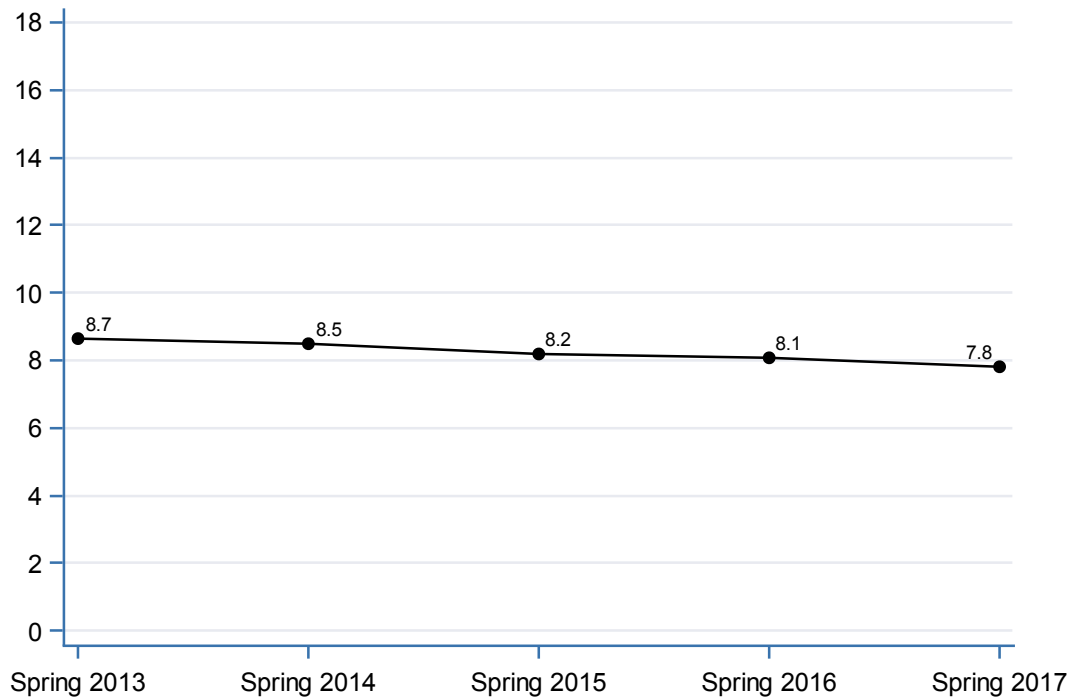

### Average Hours

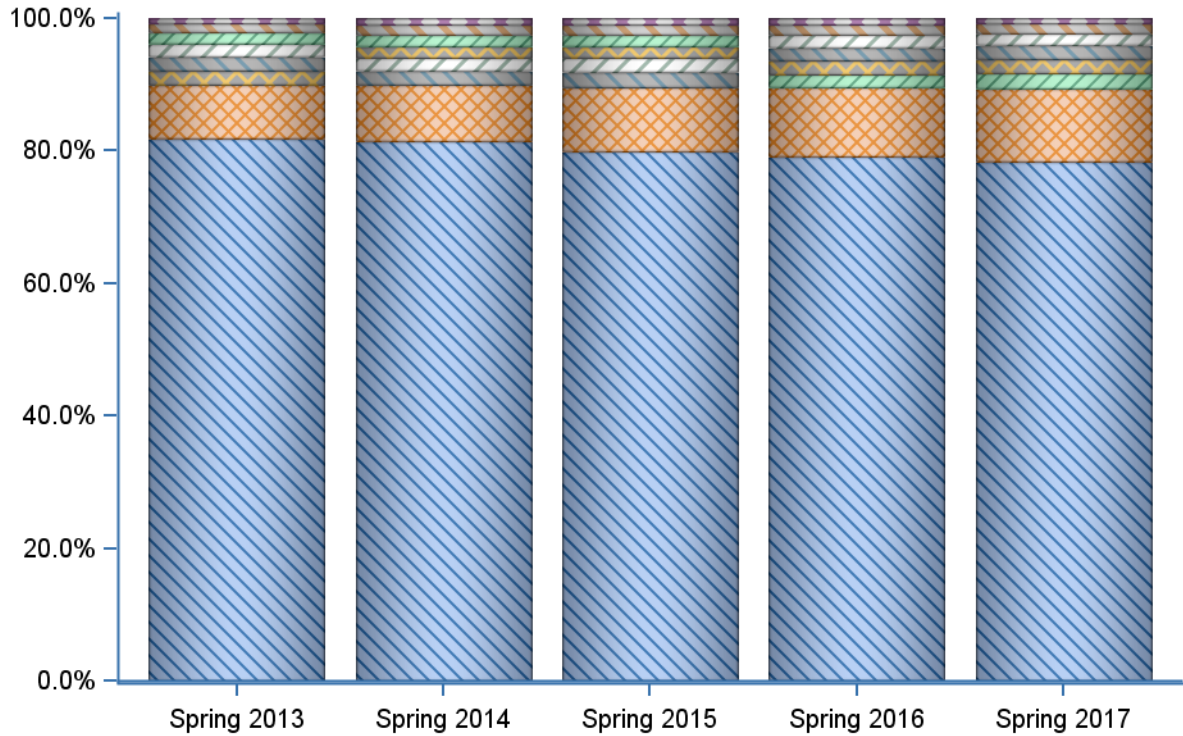

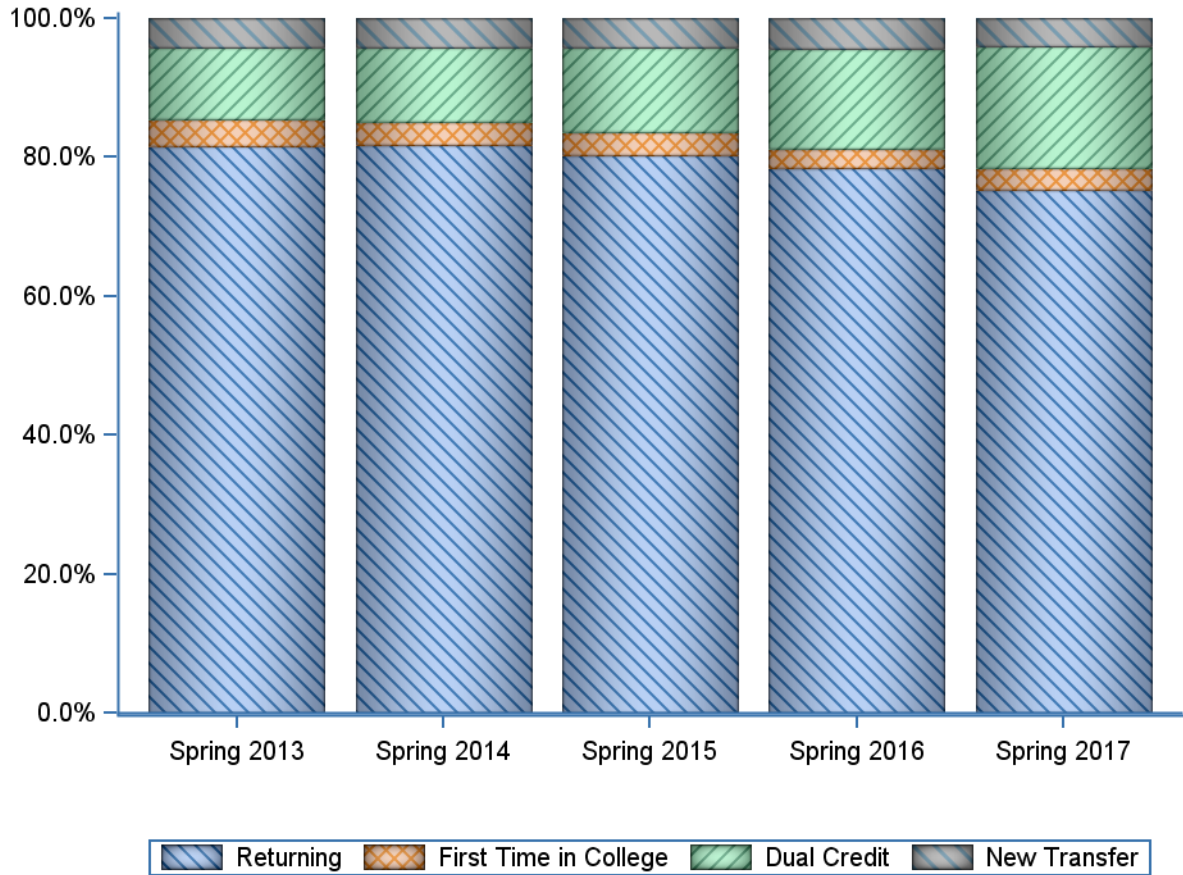
### Percent of Enrollment



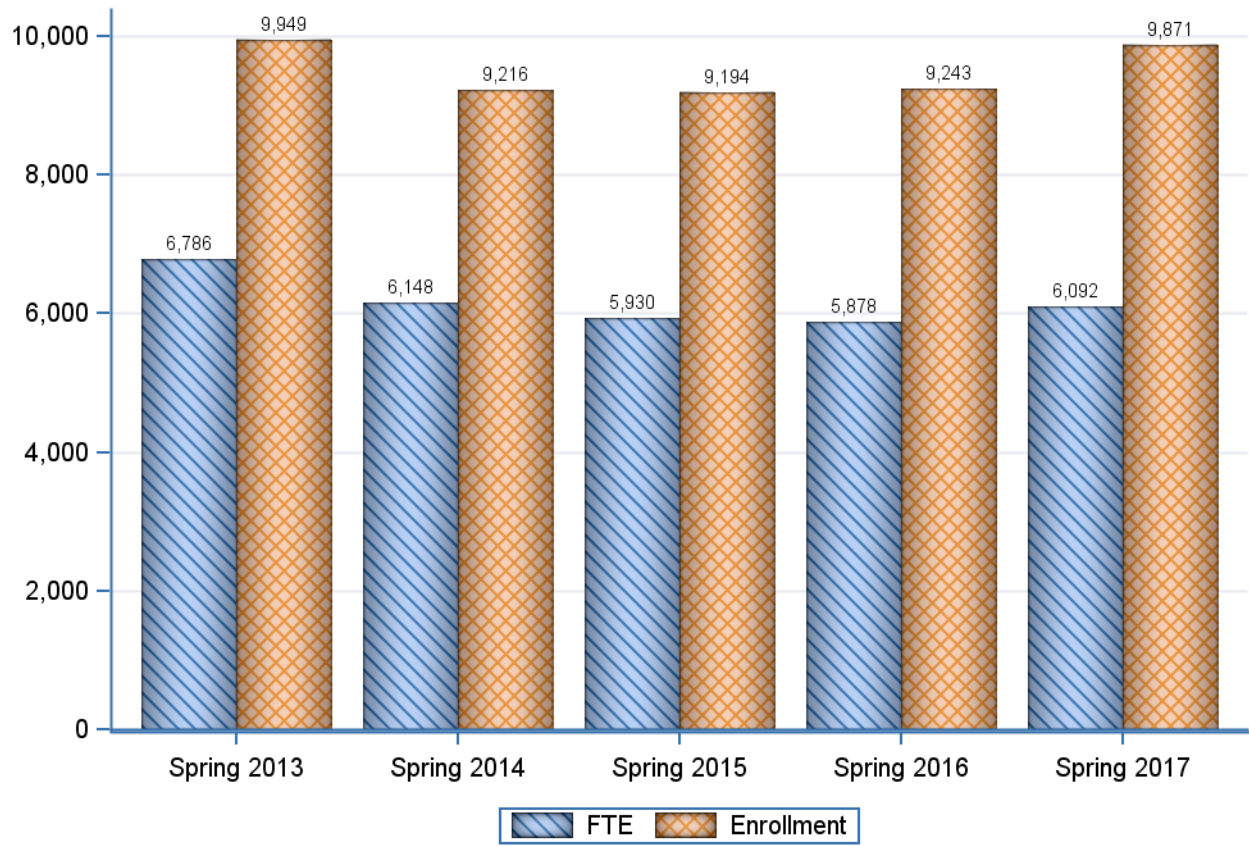
