Executive Summary

Spring 2019

The undergraduate enrollment of 10,047 included 288 first-time-in-college students, 646 new transfer students, 2,100 dual-credit students, and 7,013 returning students. Seventy-seven percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-eight percent of students are female, and fifty percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty-four percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 24.3 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-four percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four-year school. Using the state definition of full time (which excludes flex classes), twenty-nine percent are full-time students. The overall average credit-hour load excluding flex classes is 7.6. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to fifty percent, and the average credit-hour load is 11.03.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (48.9%), General Studies (11.3%), Transient, Non-Degree Seeker (7.8%), Business Administration & Management (3.5%), and Medical/Clinical Assistant (2.1%).

Spring 2018

The undergraduate enrollment of 9,861 included 293 first-time-in-college students, 341 new transfer students, 1,988 dual-credit students, and 7,239 returning students. Seventy-eight percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-seven percent of students are female, and forty-nine percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty-three percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 24.9 years at the beginning of the fall term.

Seventy-one percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four-year school. Using the state definition of full time (which excludes flex classes), thirty percent are full-time students. The overall average credit-hour load excluding flex classes is 7.7. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to fifty-two percent, and the average credit-hour load is 11.25.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (43.4%), General Studies (13.3%), Transient, Non-Degree Seeker (7.2%), Business Administration & Management (3.8%), and Registered Nursing (2.4%).
