## Executive Summary

### **Spring 2019**

The undergraduate new-transfer enrollment is 646. Fifty-three percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-two percent of students are female, and forty-nine percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Forty-six percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 25.1 years at the beginning of the spring term.

Seventy-eight percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four-year school. Using the state definition of full time (which excludes flex classes), twenty-four percent are full-time students. The overall average credit-hour load excluding flex classes is 6.7. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to sixty-one percent, and the average credit-hour load is 12.7.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Transient, Non-Degree Seeker (44.3%), Liberal Arts & Sciences (23.5%), General Studies (6.6%), Business Administration and Management (5.0%), and Business/Commerce, General (2.6%).

### **Spring 2018**

The undergraduate new-transfer enrollment is 341. Fifty-three percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-three percent of students are female, and forty-six percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Twenty-nine percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 28.4 years at the beginning of the spring term.

Sixty-eight percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four-year school. Using the state definition of full time (which excludes flex classes), thirty-seven percent are full-time students. The overall average credit-hour load excluding flex classes is 8.7. If flex classes are included, the percentage of full-time students jumps to fifty-four percent, and the average credit-hour load is 10.3.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (29.5%), Transient, Non-Degree Seeker (18.32%), General Studies (10.9%), Business Administration and Management (6.2%), and Hospital and Health Care Facilities Administration/Management (3.4%).
